

Tips and tricks for a successful interview

Be prepared

Please review the job description and familiarise yourself with the role. Think about how your skills and experience fit the opportunity you're applying for, and consider what questions we might ask.

Test your tech

If you're joining remotely, ensure your Wi-Fi works, and that your camera and audio are working perfectly. Check the lighting and position yourself in front of the camera. Have anything you might need within reach and minimise distractions, such as your mobile phone, to help maintain your focus.

Plan your journey

For in-person interviews, familiarise yourself with the interview location and plan the best route to get there. Aim to arrive at least 15 minutes ahead of schedule to allow for delays and to give us plenty of time to check you in.

Be yourself

We want to understand what attracted you to the role and why you want to join us at AerFin - but more importantly, we want to get to know you and what makes you tick. It's not always easy to act naturally in an interview, but do try to show the real you. If you need us to change anything to help you perform at your best, just ask and we'll do our best to accommodate.
